



#### Trustees to move ahead with goals for district's LEAD 2.0 strategic plan

GRAPEVINE-COLLEYVILLE ISD The Grapevine-Colleyville ISD board of trustees approved new goals for LEAD 2.0 to advance its current LEAD 2021. The vote passed 6-1, with trustee Jorge Rodriguez voting against.

LEAD stands for Leading Excellence-Action Driven. The district describes LEAD as a plan that impacts every aspect of GCISD through core objectives and specific strategies.

Each of these goals is accompanied by a picture of success, detailing the end goal for students, parents, the district, and, where applicable, school structures, according to the district's meeting documents.

Over the past eight months more than 1,000 GCISD stakeholders contributed to the process of refining the current LEAD 2021 strategic plan

Design learning environments that support social and emotional well-being

Create a culture that fosters learning environments that reflect student voice and promote student engagement

Effectively communicate with targeted audiences

to create the next steps that will be called LEAD 2.0, according to district documents. Four new goals were developed by the staff, students, trustees and the community with the aim to build on LEAD 2021.

"I do not feel the goals reflect strong academic goals for us to continue to achieve as we have now in LEAD 2021," Rodriguez said before the vote took place.

#### Council, planning and zoning give green light to apartment and hotel combination development

GRAPEVINE A fivestory hotel with dual branding from Holiday Inn and Staybridge Suites and four apartment buildings will be coming to 20 acres at 2103 Anderson-Gibson Road, Grapevine. Grapevine City Council approved a master site plan Dec. 18 for the hotels and apartment buildings.



The Carter apartment residences will compliment the Staybridge and Holiday Inn hotel in the development.

The hotels will offer more than 10,000 square feet of meeting space and more than 300 hotel rooms, of which 155 rooms will be for the Holiday Inn and 148 rooms for Staybridge Suites. The hotel development will include a restaurant, and both developments will have their own swimming pool.

The apartments, called The Carter, will be four stories tall and offer 275 units in a range of sizes. The development will be united with open lawns and community plazas to focus on walkability, said Kenneth W. Fambro, vice president of Integrated Housing Solutions, in his presentation to

#### School district schedules open forum for Southlake students to talk about experiences in diversity

CARROLL ISD District officials scheduled a special session board meeting from 6-7:30 p.m. Jan. 16 to talk with high school students about diversity. The session will be at The Marq Southlake at 285 Shady Oaks Drive, Southlake.

Although it will be open to the public, the meeting will primarily be for students to meet with CISD board members and have an open dialogue about their experiences.

This conversation aims to advance CISD's cultural competence action plan, which includes several other

recommendations to foster a safe, inclusive learning environment for all students. The plan was developed in response to a video posted on social media in October by students filmed using a derogatory racial slur.

Additionally the school district is reviewing applications from community members interested in participating on CISD's district- and campus-level diversity councils. Council members will review and advise the school board on recommendations to improve cultural competence in the community.

#### Grapevine council approves zoning variances for new Stand Rock water park

#### BY MIRANDA JAIMES

Grapevine City Council approved attraction overlays for the new Stand Rock Resort and water park, marking a step forward in the development initially approved in 2016.

Stand Rock will be Grapevine's third water park, and it will be located within three miles of the city's two other water parks and resorts, Great Wolf Lodge and the Gaylord Texan Resort, at 3509 N. Grapevine Mills Blvd., Grapevine.

The project is expected to cost approximately \$330 million.

The attraction overlay approved Dec. 18 provides for variances not permitted under the current zoning, such as height restrictions. It also addresses entertainment options such as outdoor dining, miniature bowling and a ropes course.

"Stand Rock Grapevine will establish a competitive advantage by designing distinctly different and a significantly broader array of amenities than those that exist today at other water parks within the area,"

a letter from Stand Rock to the city of Grapevine dated Dec. 7 stated.

The amenities mentioned include expansive waterslide offerings, an entertainment center and Texas-themed guest rooms, according to the letter.

"The rugged pioneer style takes its design cues from the culture and geography of North Texas," the letter states. "The resort interior design will reflect the various cultures and lifestyle of the people that have

historically called Grapevine home."

Applicant Stu Zadra said in his council meeting presentation the resort would have a restaurant, buffets and a snack bar.

The Grapevine planning and zoning commission and the council expressed their enthusiasm for the resort as a whole.

"It's a great project," Council Member Mike Lease said.

Zadra said he expects the hotel to open in 2021.





#### DFW Connector project ramps up bridge work at SH 121 to reduce road congestion

#### BY MIRANDA JAIMES

Work that started in July will continue through 2019 to relieve roadway congestion that commonly occurs along three miles of SH 121.

The \$370 million Texas Department of Transportation project includes rebuilding and widening SH 121 north of the Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport to accommodate new interchanges at I-635 and FM 2499. The Bass Pro Drive bridge in Grapevine will also be widened to six lanes and reconstructed along with the frontage roads of Bass Pro Drive, SH 121 and FM 2499.


"Utility relocations, drainage, grading and paving work will take place throughout the [project]," Alyssa Tenorio, NorthGate Constructors public information manager, said in an email. "There will also be traffic switches throughout the project, and we encourage everyone to pay attention to new alignments and roadway signage."

Crews will start work on both the east and west intersections at Bass Pro and SH 121 in the first few months of 2019. Additionally, work on the east side of Bass Pro will continue through the spring with crews setting bridge beams and building the bridge deck.

Motorists will experience bridge work along the northbound SH 26 off-ramp to SH 121; the southbound SH 121/FM 2499 off-ramp to eastbound I-635; the northbound SH 121 collector distributor bridge; the northbound SH 121 off-ramp to FM 2499; and the westbound I-635 off-ramps to northbound and southbound SH 121.

"This [project] will help everybody," Tarrant County Commissioner Gary Fickes, whose precinct includes Grapevine, Colleyville and Southlake, said in a previous interview with Community Impact Newspaper. That area "is just a chokepoint."

The project is expected to be complete in 2022.







### TEXRail trains signal redevelopment of Dallas Road

Grapevine to activate downtown station with attractions; will add features to make corridor more pedestrian-friendly

#### BY MIRANDA JAIMES

Grapevine plans to use Trinity Metro's TEXRail commuter rail line as tools for economic development.

An estimated 8,000 passengers are expected to ride the trains each day in the first year, Trinity Metro statistics show. That number is projected to grow to nearly 14,000 passengers by 2035. The trains will have nine stops along the route from Fort Worth to the Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport Terminal B.

Grapevine City Manager Bruno Rumbelow said the city will spend about \$10 million to redevelop the pedestrian corridor between Dooley Street and Ball Street into a more pedestrian-friendly and visually appealing area.

"That section becomes incredibly valuable and walkable and fun and cool," Rumbelow said.

TEXRail was scheduled to run starting Jan. 5, but operations were postponed after TEXRail had not obtained proper clearance to operate the entire line and a problem was found with the train signals. Passenger service instead began Jan. 10.

#### **MAIN STATION PROJECTS**

The area surrounding the rail stop near the corner of Dallas Road and Main Street is called Grapevine Main.

In addition to the TEXRail platform, Grapevine Main will have a train station with an observation tower, the boutique Hotel Vin, a community plaza and a parking garage. Coury Hospitality will manage the parking garage, the hotel and most of the train station.

Mark Brooks, a development partner for the project, presented design and layout plans for the connected hotel and train station during Grapevine's economic partnership meeting Nov. 28.

The train station will house Harvest Hall, which Brooks compared to an artisanal, high-quality food hall, similar to Legacy Hall in Plano.

"Food halls are growing across America rapidly, and it seems to be the way people want to eat right now, where you have choice [and] you have variety," Brooks said at the Grapevine November economic



Existing Grapevine business owners will also have a chance to set up inside the station or hotel to interact with guests and visitors, Brooks said.

"We really want to bring a local part into [the development] and make that connection as much as we can," he said.

Rumbelow said an exciting element of the project is the extension of Dallas Area Rapid Transit services to connect Plano to the DFW Airport with the Cotton Belt Corridor.

The U.S. Department of Transportation's Build America Bureau announced in late December its approval for DART's \$908 million loan to finance the Cotton Belt Corridor Regional Rail Project. Rumbelow said this will help complete the connection by 2022.

"The Plano extension crosses a couple of DART lines, so it gives people access from all over," Rumbelow said. "It really does open the entire Metroplex up to the airport, which by extension opens it up to Grapevine, which is the whole idea."



"We're going to show the art form of glass to so

many new people," Shumate said. "They may have been to different studios in different states and countries, and it is so fun to hear about those visits."

#### **DOWNTOWN ACTIVATION**

To help fund the Dallas Road corridor project, the city received a \$5 million grant through the North Central Texas Council of Governments that will be matched with local funds.

The enhancements include center medians for added safety while crossing the street as well as protected left turns for vehicles.

"There's two things coming in on [Dallas Road] really quickly," Rumbelow said. "One of them being an overlay that will basically be a road map for developers to use it to develop along the corridor. ... The other is the physical infrastructure build to make Dallas Road different than what it is today: more pedestrian-friendly, more walkable, more beautiful with better lighting and landscaping."

Rumbelow said the city has identified about 175 acres that will be most affected by TEXRail. This area is called the Grapevine Transit District, but City Council plans to rename it. Names such as The Belt, and The Yards were suggested at an Oct. 16 meeting, but the council has not made a final decision.

Developers have already come in looking to purchase and redevelop certain areas of Dallas Road, which Rumbelow said is ideal.

"That's sort of the plan, that parcel-acquisition process by the private sector," he said. The private sector can make exciting event spaces, such as life better than a city government could, he said.

Officials plan for these developments to attract more pedestrians and tourists to the area, but no projections have yet been made. These tourism-projection studies will take place once the trains have been in operation for several months, said Kimber Foster, marketing director for the Grapevine Convention and Visitors Bureau. This is to provide officials a better idea of the actual TEXRail ridership.

State Farm Insurance Agent Mike Davis has been in his office off Main Street for more than 45 years. During his time there, he said he has seen downtown Grapevine change immensely, and it will probably change even more.

"We have to keep expanding and improving what we have," Davis said. "And I think that's going to happen. In 10 years there's no telling what Grapevine is going to look like from Dallas Road to the highway."


The city of Grapevine will continue to hone its vision for Dallas Road and the developments at Grapevine Main as these projects come before City Council for approval, Rumbelow said.

"We're cooking, but we're not done," he said. "We have work to do with the council on both of these concepts, but it's all out there; it's been worked on; ... So it's coming."

#### Lawmakers will consider school finance and taxes

**WHAT WE REPORTED** Elected officials face mounting pressure over the school finance system, which relies heavily on local property taxes, according to a December news report published in *Community Impact Newspaper*.

THE LATEST State Rep. Giovanni Capriglione, R-Southlake, met with Carroll ISD officials to discuss priorities ahead of the 86th legislative session, which began Jan. 8. He said school finance reform—which is closely tied to property tax reform—will remain at the forefront of legislative discussions. Of particular concern are the number of property-wealthy school districts paying the state "Robin Hood" money to redistribute to property-poor districts. Capriglione said these recapture payments will not be going away, but the amounts paid could be frozen or lowered.

**WHAT'S NEXT** In addition to advocating for more money for public education, Capriglione said he will author or co-author bills to increase the maximum homestead exemption rate to provide further relief to property owners. Recently elected state Sen. Beverly Powell, D-Burleson, said she will support a full-scale funding reform in education.



#### Construction on SH 26 to include landcape, lighting

**WHAT WE REPORTED** Some local businesses attributed faltering sales to the construction taking place on SH 26, even as road work moved to a new phase. The city of Colleyville introduced quarterly promotions to help businesses.

**THE LATEST** The \$38.2 million project is scheduled for completion in mid-2019. The Texas Department of Transportation offers financial incentives for early completion and penalties for delays.

WHAT'S NEXT In early 2019, asphalt and concrete work is planned from Tinker Road south to Hall-Johnson Road. Storm drain installation will continue from Hall-Johnson to the south of Main Street. Traffic on Hall-Johnson and Church Street on the east side at SH 26 have switched to new pavement to allow for reconstruction of the other half of each side street. In addition, the city is coordinating its efforts with TxDOT to take over landscaping for the project and is hopeful for a seamless transition from road construction to landscape enhancements. The city has earmarked \$3 million for the lighting of the corridor, but will probably spend only about half of that, Assistant City Manager Adrienne Lothery said. Any remaining money can be used to make the corridor more attractive in other ways. The council has decided on lighting and is planning to enhance the beauty of the road once TxDOT has finished road work.


#### Grapevine tourism grows with new city attractions

**WHAT WE REPORTED** Projects in Grapevine include \$11 million in renovations at Great Wolf Lodge, the ongoing developments of Salt Lick BBQ and Stand Rock Resort and water park and the Vineyard Tower addition at Gaylord Texan Resort.


THE LATEST Grapevine City Council approved attraction overlays Dec. 18 for the Stand Rock Resort and water park to allow some flexibility with zoning restrictions. Project applicant Stu Zadra said he anticipates the hotel to premier in 2021 and timeshare condominiums to be added in 2022. Developers for Salt Lick BBQ are working on financing for the project, which was originally slated for completion in 2019. That date may extend into 2020, Grapevine Economic Development Director Bob Farley said.

what's Next Construction for Stand Rock Resort and water park may begin as early as April, Farley said. The project will be finished in phases—the first of which may take roughly 15 months, depending on uncontrollable factors like weather. City Council also approved in December a site plan for four apartment buildings and a five-story hotel, which is a collaboration between Holiday Inn and Staybridge Suites. Details about the project's timeline will be announced later.




#### Grapevine's short-term rental ban moves to trial

**WHAT WE REPORTED** Grapevine and South-lake instituted a ban on short-term rentals, such as those that can be found on websites such as Airbnb and HomeAway. Grapevine property owners who opposed the ban filed a lawsuit Oct. 18.

**THE LATEST** Judge Mike Wallach granted the property owners' request Nov. 7, preventing the city from enforcing its ban on short-term rentals for these plaintiffs. A trial to determine whether the city was within its rights is set for April 15, according to court documents.

what's NEXT Graig Fancher, one of the attorneys representing the plaintiffs, said the case is in the discovery phase as both sides gather information for the trial. Fancher said the suit challenges the ban on three grounds, the first being an unconstitutional takings claim, in which the plaintiffs would seek several years to recover some of their investment into their short-term rental properties. The second is that the ban violates the plaintiff's substantive due process rights, meaning the city did not have a good reason to ban short-term rentals. The third claim is that the statute is preempted under state law because the Texas Legislature taxes short-term rentals.






